



Kathryn Olmstead Ringer

Kathryn Olmstead Ringer, 91, of Stevers Mill Road, Broadalbin died Friday March 25, 2016 at the Wells Nursing Home in Johnstown.

She was born in Broadalbin on September 11, 1924 a daughter of Joseph and Mary Vail Olmstead and was educated in local schools. Kathryn was a 1966 graduate of the Amsterdam School of Practical Nursing.

She was employed at Mohawk Carpet Mills for several years. Later, Mrs. Ringer was employed as a licensed practical nurse at Nathan Littauer Hospital in Gloversville for twenty one years, retiring in 1986.

Kathryn was a member of the Perth Bible Church and the Broadalbin Senior Citizens Club.

She was married to Boyd H. Ringer on December 4, 1943. He died on February 27, 1987. In addition to her husband and parents, she was predeceased by her sisters, Margaret Zajaceskowski and Henrietta Fisler.

Survivors include four sons, Harvey (Lianne) Ringer of Gloversville, Charles Ringer of Broadalbin, Dennis (Suzanne) Ringer of Rising Sun, MD, and David Ringer of Johnstown; seven grandchildren; twelve great-grandchildren; and several nieces, nephews, and cousins.
