Kathryn Helen Trigg, 55, of East Berne, passed away unexpectedly at home on Monday, February 2, 2026, following a brief illness.

She was born in Ballston Spa on July 22, 1970, the daughter of John and Betty (Armer) Trigg. Kathryn was a graduate of Galway High School. She later attended SUNY Potsdam and ultimately made East Berne her home.

Kathryn was employed by the New York State Department of Education as a licensure clerk. She also put her genuine personality to good use while working at Ketchums Store in Altamont, where she enjoyed the camaraderie of the local community.
