Kenneth R. "Chet" Stutzke, Jr., 73, of Ridge Road, Amsterdam, passed away at home on Wednesday morning, January 21, 2026.

He was born in Amsterdam on December 13, 1952, a son of Kenneth and Mildred Gage Stutzke and attended school in Perth. Chet was a lifelong area resident.

He was employed for nearly 10 years at Lancaster Construction in Cobleskill. In 1980, Chet established Ken & Sons Trucking in Amsterdam, that he owned and operated until retiring in 2016.

Chet loved old cars, antique hot rods, and attending car shows. He loved boating, motorcycling, and RV camping. Chet was known as Transmission as a CBer.

He was a former member of the Polish American Veterans in Amsterdam and the American Legion in Broadalbin.

In addition to his parents, Chet was predeceased by a son, Kenneth III.

Survivors include his longtime companion, Beth Covell; a son, Louis (Nancy) Stutzke of Gloversville; a daughter-in-law, Anna Stutzke of Amsterdam; a sister, Linda Stutzke (Jeff Chandler) of Perth; a grandson, Austin Stutzke; and several aunts, uncles, and cousins.
