



## Kenneth L. Tyler

August 19, 1963 - June 12, 2022

Kenneth L. Tyler, 58, of Blanchard Loop, Gloversville, died suddenly on Sunday, June 12, 2022, after being stricken at home.

He was born in Amsterdam on August 19, 1963, a son of Lewis Tyler and Barbara Crandall Tyler and was a 1983 graduate of Perth Central School. Ken later earned an Associate's degree in Auto Mechanics from FMCC. He was a lifelong area resident.

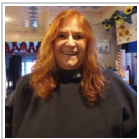
