June 12, 1974 - April 29, 2025

Kimberly Ross, 50, of County Highway 107, Amsterdam, passed away on Tuesday, April 29, 2025, at her brother's home in the town of Mayfield—most likely still insisting the house was “too warm” even with the windows open.

Born in Amsterdam on June 12, 1974, Kim was the daughter of Michael and Georgeann Sikirica Ross. She graduated from Broadalbin-Perth High School in 1992, went on to FMCC, and later earned a bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice from Russell Sage College. She was smart, fiercely loyal, and always up for a good debate—even if she was the only one in it.

Kim proudly raised her daughter as a stay-at-home mom, eventually joining The Home Depot team in Amsterdam. Though she wasn't a DIY expert herself, she knew exactly who to ask and always had a shortcut for everything.

She loved Hallmark and Lifetime movies—especially when they were predictable—and found great joy in “talking sense” to the characters. She also had a firm belief that fresh air solved everything. Even in the dead of winter, she'd crack the windows just enough to turn the bedroom into a crisp 50-degree paradise. “It's refreshing,” she'd say, smoking a cigarette with a cup of coffee, completely unbothered.

Kim was predeceased by her parents, whom she loved deeply and probably argued with from time to time—just to keep things interesting.

She is survived by her daughter and greatest joy, Kaylee Matarazzo of Albany; three siblings: Patrick Brooker and Kelly Marriott, both of Amsterdam, and

Kevin Ross of Broadalbin, who learned early never to touch the thermostat without permission; and her devoted dog and sidekick, Gizmo, who adored her beyond words.

Cremation was performed at Park View Crematorium in Schenectady. In keeping with her wishes (and her dislike of being the center of attention), no formal services will be held. The family invites you to honor Kim in your own way: open a window, sip something warm, and say something smart with just a hint of sarcasm.
