Larry W. Eglin, 77, of Broadalbin, passed away Friday, February 11, 2022, at Ellis Hospital, Schenectady following a short illness.

He was born in Amsterdam on January 1, 1945, a son of Kenneth and Alta Sanders Eglin and was educated in Broadalbin. Larry was a lifelong resident of Broadalbin.

For ten years, he owned and operated his own logging company. Later, Larry was employed as a bus driver for the Broadalbin-Perth School District for fifty years. He also worked opening graves and was a caretaker for four local cemeteries as recently as two years ago. Larry also owned and operated a bottle redemption center in Broadalbin which is still in operation today by his family.

He was very well known by so many people and really enjoyed chatting with anyone about anything any chance he got. Larry most likely knew everyone in Broadalbin.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by two brothers, Dale and Keith Eglin; and a sister, Bonnie Horton-Olbie.
