Lee W. Zierak, 64, of Perth, passed away Friday, March 25, 2022, at Albany Medical Center.

He was born in Amsterdam on October 19, 1957, a son of William and Sylvia Jennings Zierak and was a 1975 graduate of Perth Central School. While in school, Lee studied woodworking at BOCES. He was a lifelong area resident. Mr. Zierak was employed as a truck driver for the Town of Perth Highway Department for thirty-eight years before retiring in 2013.

Lee was a member of the Amsterdam United Methodist Church.

He was a member of the American Legion Post #337 and the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #8690, both in Broadalbin. Lee was involved in many fundraising events and barbeques, and also tended bar at the VFW after retiring.

Lee had an extensive workshop in his garage and enjoyed spending time there. He also was an avid bowler and enjoyed golfing, camping, hunting, and fishing.

He was predeceased by his father, William.

Survivors include his mother, Sylvia Zierak of Perth; his significant other, Carolyn Bailey; a brother, Brent Zierak of Broadalbin; three children, Christopher Zierak (Madeline) of Bleecker, Deidre Zierak of Gloversville, and Cameron Zierak of Northville; three grandchildren, Kylee, Ronan, and Mirabella Zierak; and several nieces, nephews, and cousins.
