Lenita Maureen Shattuck Miller, 86, formerly of Progress Road, Gloversville, went home to her Lord on Friday, October 20, 2017 at St. Peter's Hospital, Albany after a brief illness.

She was born in Gloversville on November 4, 1930, the daughter of Paul Adrian Shattuck and Grace Behlen and was a 1948 graduate of Broadalbin High School.
