Loretta I. Ahnert, 92, of County Highway 107, Amsterdam died Tuesday March 21, 2017 at St. Mary's Healthcare.

She was born in Perth on March 11, 1925 a daughter of Walter and Grace Austin Ahnert and attended school there. Loretta was a lifelong Perth resident.

She was employed at the former Mohawk Carpet Mills and later owned and operated the former Perth Diner for twenty seven years, retiring in 1989.

Loretta was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Broadalbin.

Loretta served as trustee and co-treasurer of the Perth Cemetery, and was the sexton of the cemetery for nearly ten years. She was a member of the Perth Senior Citizens, the Perth Historical Society, and a member and past president of the former Perth Road Merchant Association. In addition, Loretta was an honorary member of both the Perth Fire Company Auxiliary and the Order of the Eastern Star, Broadalbin Chapter 487.

In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by a sister and brother-in-law, Elizabeth and Douglas Manzer; her step-brother-in-law, Earl McGinnis; and a grandson, Donald Tyler.

Survivors include a son, Neal E. Tyler, of Herminie, PA; a daughter, Nancy (Henry) Mars of Perth; a step-sister, Nancy McGillis of Johnstown; three grandsons, Kevin M. Bardascini, Rea Tyler, and Chad (Angela) Tyler; two granddaughters, Cherie Mars and Sandra (Chris) Holloway; and four great-granddaughters.

Cremation was performed at Park View Crematorium, Schenectady. Calling hours will be held on Saturday from 11 am – noon at the Robert M. Halgas Funeral Home, Inc. 111 County Highway 106 (Corner of Route 29 & Black Street), Johnstown. A memorial service will follow at noon with Rev. Linda Martin, officiating.
