Margaret H. Gegenheimer, 93, formerly of Woods Hollow Road, Gloversville, passed away on Friday, December 27, 2024, at her daughter's home in Broadalbin.

She was born in Brooklyn on March 28, 1931, a daughter of Robert and Hazel McKenna Marryatt and attended school there. Margaret moved to Gloversville in 1966.

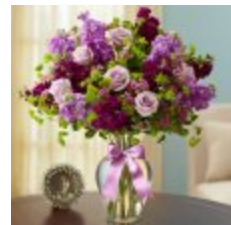
