Margaret "Peg" A. Halpin, 83, of Old State Road, Broadalbin died Thursday May 4, 2017 at St. Mary's Healthcare, Amsterdam with loving family at her side.

She was born in New York City on May 12, 1933 a daughter of Henry and Mary McCartin Nugent and was a graduate of Bayside High School. Peg lived in Levittown, Long Island for ten years before moving to Broadalbin in 1972.
