Mark A. Brady, 71, a resident of the town of Mayfield, passed away on Thursday, June 12, 2025, at Nathan Littauer Hospital, Gloversville, after fighting a long and courageous battle with IPF.

He was born in Chicago, IL on June 4, 1954, a son of James and Dorothy Rasmussen Brady, and moved with his family to the hamlet of Fish House, NY. Mark was a 1972 graduate of Broadalbin Central School. While in school, he completed a 2-year class at BOCES to learn the trade of an electrician. His instructor was impressed by his ability and took Mark on as an apprentice for his business. He later worked for Perham Electric and Lou's Electric, and then as a maintenance manager at the former Esquire Novelty. Mark retired in June 2013 from Liberty ARC in Amsterdam, where he worked in maintenance.

He enjoyed hunting, fishing, and target shooting, especially with his grandson, Bobby. Mark was a member of the Fish House Fish and Game Club.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by a sister, Laura Jessop, his mother-in-law, Dorothy Reckner, and a sister-in-law, Brenda Nusser.

Survivors include his love, Gay Reckner Brady, whom he married on July 19, 1975, and would have celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary next month; two children, Jeffrey (Jillian) of Brooklyn, NY and Erin (Kane) of Esperance; three grandchildren, Alyssa, Bobby, and Grayson; five siblings, Irene (Bill) Thomas, Kathleen Berquist, and Celeste Brady, all of Alameda, CA, Paul (Darlene) Brady of Johnstown, and Ellen (Alex) Nedo of Broadalbin; a brother- and sister-in-law, Jack and Carol Reckner, and a sister-in-law, Sally Reckner.
