Mark A. Massacesi, 54, of Franklin Street, Gloversville, passed away at home on Thursday, January 16, 2025.

He was born in Amsterdam on November 5, 1970, a son of Bruno and Jeanne Tomlinson Massacesi, and was a 1989 graduate of Broadalbin-Perth High School. Mark was a lifelong area resident.

He was employed with several local carpenters throughout the years, including John Carpenter and Greg Bombard. At the time of his death, Mark was working with Kucel Contractors in Gloversville.

He attended St. Joseph's Church in Broadalbin and served as an altar boy there when he was young.

Mark loved being outdoors and enjoyed deer hunting, fishing, and camping. He loved sports, especially football, and was a NY Giant fan. Mark also had a soft heart for animals, especially his dogs.

He was predeceased by his father, Bruno, in 2014.
