Martin W. Campbell, 85, of Rebisz Road, Broadalbin, passed away at home on Monday morning, November 11, 2024.

He was born in Plattsburg on February 25, 1939, a son of Martin and Elizabeth Ahern Campbell and attended Oneida High School. Martin moved to Broadalbin in 1970.

Mr. Campbell worked as a heavy equipment operator for many local companies, including BBL in Albany.

He proudly served in the US Navy aboard the U.S.S. Coral Sea and the U.S.S. Mount Baker and was honorably discharged in 1960.

Martin enjoyed hunting and fishing, watching his favorite sports teams, and he co-owned several racehorses in Saratoga.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by a sister, Roberta Purcell, a brother, Roger Campbell, and a stepsister, Doris Reiss.
