



Mary Sokach Civic

January 14, 1915 - April 8, 2016

Mary Sokach Civic, 101, formerly of Fish House Road Broadalbin, died Friday evening April 8, 2016 at the Wilkinson Residential Health Care Facility, with her loving family at her side.

She was born in Yonkers, NY on January 14, 1915 a daughter of Thomas and Paraska Pariek Sokach and moved to Linden, NJ at the age of six. Mary moved to Mosherville, NY when she married and lived briefly in Amsterdam before moving to the Town of Providence where she lived for most of her life. Mrs. Civic was a communicant of St. Joseph's Church in Broadalbin and was a member of the Altar Rosary Society. She was also a member of the Kateri League at Auriesville.

Mrs. Civic was a charter member of the Providence Ambulance Corp and was also a member of the Ladies Auxiliary of the Providence Volunteer Fire Department for over thirty years. Mary was a member of the Broadalbin Senior Citizens Club and served as treasurer for several years.

She enjoyed gardening, crocheting, and spending time with family and friends.

She married John Civic on June 3, 1934. He died on September 10, 1996. In addition to her husband and parents, she was predeceased by her brothers, Andrew and John; her sisters, Helen, Eve, and Ann; and her son, John.

Survivors include a daughter, Betty Jane Satterlee of Broadalbin; a daughter-in-law, Marilyn Civic of Broadalbin; a sister, Pauline Schmidt of Schenectady; ten grandchildren; ten great-grandchildren; and several nieces, nephews, and cousins.

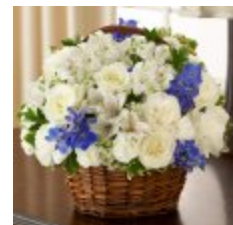
