Mary Magalata Renda, 94, passed away Friday, January 29, 2021 at St. Mary's Healthcare, Amsterdam. For the past five years, she was a resident of the Sarah Jane Sanford Home for Women.

She was born in Gloversville on December 8, 1926 to Ralph and Theresa Christiano Viola and attended Gloversville School District. Mary was a lifelong area resident.

In her early working years, Mary made gloves at home for several area glovemakers. While her children were in school, she worked as an aide for the Gloversville School District. Mrs. Renda was employed at Grandoe Gloves for many years and later worked for Peter Kiernan at P.K. Gloves. After retirement, Mary went on to assist students with special needs in area school districts. She took a great deal of pride in her work over the years.

Mary was a very devoted Catholic and was a member of the former Mt. Carmel Church and the current Church of the Holy Spirit. She was a member of the Junior Mothers of Mt. Carmel Church for many years.

Mary earned a Bachelor of Square Dancing degree that she was most proud of and she enjoyed attending dances. She was a member of the Gloversville Senior Center. Mary enjoyed horse racing and played pinochle with her card group for the past thirty years. She was a tremendous cook and loved holiday baking, and teaching younger generations how to prepare her famous Italian dishes.

Mary was married to Salvatore J. Renda on March 28, 1948. He died on November 16, 1997. In addition to her husband and parents, Mary was predeceased by her son, Thomas Renda, and most recently, her daughter, Teresa Jaquay-Schrader.

Survivors include her daughter, Linda (Rick) Mendetta of Gloversville; her brother, Dominic "Mimi" (Irene) Viola of Gloversville; Julia Szurek of Amsterdam; her seven grandchildren,
