



Merwin E. Coolidge

May 28, 1931 - September 8, 2024

Merwin E. Coolidge, 93, of Ephratah, and formerly of Gloversville, passed away on Sunday, September 8, 2024, at St. Mary's Healthcare in Amsterdam. He was born in Grand Isle, VT on May 28, 1931, a son of Obadiah and Avis Martin Coolidge and attended school there. Merwin moved to New York in 1956 and spent much of his adult life in the Gloversville area.

Mr. Coolidge was a truck driver for Coleco for many years and later with F&F Trucking in Fonda, retiring at the age of 80.

Merwin was a veteran of the US Army and served during the Korean War. He remained active throughout his life and enjoyed working as well as activities including skydiving, boxing, hunting, and fishing. Merwin loved birdwatching and enjoyed caring for his animals. Most of all, he valued time spent with family and friends.

He married Joan R. Chamberlain Coolidge on October 19, 1957. Sadly, she died August 16, 2016. In addition to his parents and wife, he was also predeceased by a son, Merwin Dougherty; a daughter, Alice Brown; two brothers, Merville and Eldridge Coolidge; a grandson, Evan Coolidge; and a granddaughter, Corylinn Hill.
