Michael C. Christman, 86, of East State Street, Gloversville, passed away at home on Sunday, May 17, 2026, surrounded by his loving family.

Born in Gloversville on June 6, 1939, he was a son of Charles N. and Ashley Vickery Christman. Mike was raised and educated in Johnstown and moved to Gloversville as a teen.

Mike proudly served in the United States Navy and was honorably discharged in 1960. He served on the USS The Sullivans.

He worked for Twin City Welding, formerly of Gloversville, and for a time with Buanno Trucking. Mike was employed at Cushing Stone Company in Amsterdam as a heavy equipment operator for 30 years, retiring in 2000.

Mike was a member of the American Legion Post 337 in Broadalbin, the Pine Tree Rifle Club in Johnstown, the Concordia Club in Gloversville, and Memories on Wheels in Glens Falls.

A true automotive enthusiast, Mike had a deep appreciation for all kinds of cars and Harley-Davidsons. Above all, he enjoyed spending time with his family and friends.

Survivors include his loving wife, Madonna Plumadore Christman whom he married on February 15, 1986; two daughters, Lori (Jack) Boyd of Mayfield and Lisa Christman of Gloversville; three grandsons, Jake, Kyle, and Kaleb; and three great-grandchildren, Leah, Reni, and Eli. Although Mike had no actual brothers and sisters he had a large extended family of brothers, sisters, nieces and nephews all with whom he was very close to.

He will be greatly missed.

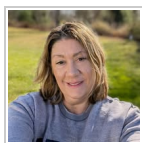
