Nate G. Sowle, 73, of Crannel Road, Galway, passed away on Friday, April 21, 2023, at St. Mary's Healthcare, Amsterdam.

Nate was a member of the Paralyzed Veterans of America.

He enjoyed working around his home and property and was proud that he built his home on his own. Nate loved spending time at home with his family and friends. He also enjoyed hunting and watching TV, especially Sci-Fi.

In addition to his parents, Nate was predeceased by a brother, Ned.

Survivors include his wife, Ann Ahn Sowle, whom he married on May 25, 1970; a son, Danny (Jennifer) Sowle of Johnstown; three brothers, Neal (Alice) Sowle and Noel (Marian) Sowle, all of Galway, and Nevin (Kym) Sowle of Rockwood, TN; three grandchildren, Hannah, Alix, and Christian; a great-granddaughter, Liara; and several nieces, nephews, and cousins.
