



Nathan Holden Kenyon Jr.

October 4, 1930 - April 14, 2023

Nathan Holden Kenyon, Jr., 92, of Gansevoort, and formerly of Broadalbin, passed away Friday morning, April 14, 2023, at the Gateway House of Peace in Ballston Spa.

He was born in Broadalbin on October 4, 1930, a son of Nathan and Myrtle DeLong, and was a 1950 graduate of Broadalbin High School. Nathan was a veteran of the US Army and served from 1951 – 53. He served in Korea from April 1952 – July 1953 with the Military Police in a POW camp.

Mr. Kenyon was employed with Mohasco Industries for forty-four years and worked in Amsterdam, NY, Bennettsville, SC, and Dublin, GA as a manager in the dyeing department, and technical service to various mills in and out of the country.

Nathan was a communicant of St. Clements Church in Saratoga Springs.

He was an avid golfer for many years and also enjoyed an occasional game of Poker at Turning Stone Casino.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his brothers, Earl Kenyon, Kenneth (Mamie) Kenyon, and Louis (Helen) Kenyon; and his sisters, Genevieve (Leon) Seward, Madeline (Lester) Weideman, and Kathleen (Sheldon) Hopes.

Survivors include his wife, Marian Banach Kenyon, whom he married in 1950 at St. Joseph's Church in Broadalbin; a daughter, Linda (Dan) Kusick of Lanesborough, MA; a son, Darryl (Kathy) Kenyon of Ocala, FL; two grandsons, Alex Kusick of Lanesborough, MA and Stan Kusick (Paige) of

Adams, MA; and several nieces and nephews.
