Oleg K. Kramar, 92, a former longtime resident of Springfield and Chicopee, MA, passed away peacefully on Saturday November 7, 2015 at the home of his granddaughter.

He was born in Russia on August 31, 1923 a son of Konstantin and Tatiana Kramarenko and lived in Germany and in Belgium before immigrating to the United States in 1952 and settling in Springfield with his family.

Upon his arrival to the United States, Oleg found work at a paper mill in Holyoke. For many years, he was a landlord who owned and maintained several apartment buildings in the Springfield area. He was employed as a mechanic for more than twenty years, first at Beaulieu Chevrolet and later with a Ford dealership until his retirement.

Oleg enjoyed summer visits to the lake house he built on Hamilton Reservoir in Holland, MA.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his wife of sixty five years, Tatiana Darahan Kramar in 2010; and their son, Dr. Arkady Kramar in 1997.

Survivors include two grandchildren, Gregory Kramar of Nashua, NH and Amy (Charles) Goebel of Gloversville, with whom he resided for the past three years; and three great-grandchildren, Emma, Derek, and Jordan Goebel.
