The daughter David and Paula Wallin-Eddy of Broadalbin, NY Olivia attended Broadalbin-Perth School District and graduated in 2017 in the top 10 in her class. Olivia was active in Girl Scouts, chorus, drama club, art club, and softball. Olivia later attended the University of Nebraska Omaha as a math major where she made the Deans list. She also participated in the UNO Air Force ROTC program. Of all her activities, Olivia most enjoyed playing softball with a dream of one day playing for Team USA in the Olympics. She was named in the 2016 and 17 editions of USSSA softballs best players in the country. She greeted all with a smile regardless of the situation, and was there to provide support when needed.
