Patricia A. Crispin, 88, of Hatzenbuhler Road, Broadalbin, passed away on Thursday, April 25, 2024, at St. Mary's Healthcare in Amsterdam.

She was born in White Plains, NY on February 25, 1936, a daughter of Robert and Ann Blennert Malone and moved to East Berne with her family as a child. Pat was a 1954 graduate of Berne Knox High School. She moved to Broadalbin in 1955.

Mrs. Crispin worked at the state offices in Albany, and in 1966 she began working at the NYS Division of Youth-Tryon School, in Johnstown. Pat retired in 1992 as a principal account clerk. Later, she was the bookkeeper at her son's business, Mike Crispin Power Equipment.

Pat was a member of the Broadalbin Kenneytto Historical Society. She enjoyed square dancing, playing computer games, and traveling. In fact, Pat took trips to Texas for 25 years, visiting relatives. She also enjoyed driving her elderly friends to appointments and other places. As recently as January 2024, Pat enjoyed swimming and water aerobics at Balanced Health in Gloversville.

She married Gerald Crispin on July 23, 1955. He died October 26, 1982. In addition to her husband and parents, Pat was predeceased by a sister, Betty, in 2008; and a brother-in-law, Lee Crispin, in 2022.

Survivors include two sons, Michael Crispin and Kenneth (Cheryl) Crispin, all of Broadalbin; a daughter, Kelli Crispin of Carrboro, NC; a sister-in-law, Barbara Crispin of Broadalbin; two nephews, John and Andrew Crispin; a

niece, Jena Wells; and several cousins.

Cremation was performed at Park View Crematorium, Schenectady. Services will be held at a later date. Arrangements are by the Robert M. Halgas Funeral Home, Inc., Johnstown.
