Pierre W. Smith, 68, of McKay Road Amsterdam, died Wednesday February 18, 2015 at Albany Medical Center.

He was born in Marseilles, France on March 24, 1946 a son of Gordon and Madeline Mary Smith and came to the United States at age two. Pierre lived in Gloversville and was a 1964 graduate of Johnstown High School. He was a US Army veteran and served during the Viet Nam War in the 101th Airborne Division. Pierre was awarded a Silver and Bronze Star, the Purple Heart, and the Good Conduct Medal. He was honorably discharged in 1971.

Pierre was a certified EMT and was employed as a respiratory therapist at Nathan Littauer Hospital and Amsterdam Memorial Hospital for many years. Later, he worked at Power Logistics in Johnstown.

Mr. Smith was a former member of the Hagaman Volunteer Fire Department and also served as a coroner in Montgomery County.

He enjoyed studying history and archaeology.

Survivors include his wife, Sharon Julie Smith, whom he married on February 14, 1971; a son, Pierre W. (Kimberly) Smith II of Glens Falls; two daughters, Sharon R. Smith of Galway and Susan M. Barron of Gloversville; a brother, Paul Smith of Schenectady; a sister, Arlette Bradt of Rotterdam; five grandchildren; and a great-grandchild.
