Raymond J. Horton, 92, of County Highway 106, Amsterdam, passed away at home early on Sunday morning, December 26, 2021, surrounded by his loving family.

He was born on December 23, 1929 in Rockville Centre, Long Island, NY a son of the late Theodore and Rose Cluchey Horton and was educated in Northville, NY. Ray moved to the town of Mayfield in 1953, residing there for sixty-nine years.

Mr. Horton was employed as a lathe operator at GE in Schenectady for thirty-four years, retiring in 1988.

He was a communicant of St. Joseph's Church in Broadalbin.

Ray was an avid gardener and outdoorsman, and enjoyed hunting, fishing, and camping in Tupper Lake. He was a member and past president of Bleeker Fish and Game Club, and a member of the Loyal Order of the Moose Lodge #1185 and the Fraternal Order of Eagles, Saratoga Aerie #2586.

He was married to Mary E. Wadsworth Horton on November 11, 1949. Sadly, she died on January 16, 2009. In addition to his wife and parents, Raymond was predeceased by a daughter, Constance Adams; a brother, Richard Horton; and a sister, Joan Tessier.

Survivors include his children, Delores (Myrt) Cyr and David Horton; grandchildren, Brian (Julia) Cyr, Stephanie (Carl) Fricke, Amanda Horton, and Nathan (Lyndsie) Adams; a brother, Homer (Wilma) Horton; two great-granddaughters, Gena and Libby; several nieces and nephews; and a special friend of the family, Monica Loux.
