Richard L. "Dick" Westfall, 65, of Hickory Hill Road, Fonda, passed away on Saturday, January 24, 2026, at home.

He was born in Amsterdam on August 10, 1960, a son of Donald J. and Patricia D. Hoes Westfall and was a 1978 graduate of Broadalbin High School. He was a lifelong area resident with the last 32 years in Fonda. As a young man, Dick worked at Coleco in Amsterdam and later at Ward Products for over 20 years until its relocation. In recent years, Dick was a truck driver, employed by Coca Cola in Albany and Green's Trucking in Amsterdam, until his retirement in 2015 due to a disability.

He was a member of Emmanuel Baptist Church in Gloversville. He was also a member of Fonda-Fultonville Community Foundation, Inc. He enjoyed jigsaw and crossword puzzles and word searches. Dick was a Miami Dolphins fan and a golf and bowling enthusiast. Above all, Dick cherished spending time with his family, especially his grandchildren.

In addition to his parents, Dick was predeceased by a sister, Mary Lou Westfall and a nephew, Michael Rehder.
