



## Richard P. Kondrat

June 27, 1953 - January 2, 2022

Richard P. Kondrat, 68, of Vunk Road, Broadalbin, passed away on Sunday, January 2, 2022, at St. Mary's Hospital, Amsterdam surrounded by his loving family.

He was born in Amsterdam on June 27, 1953, a son of Stephen and Katherine Siwik Kondrat and was a 1971 graduate of Galway High School. Richard was a lifelong area resident.

At the time of death, Dick was employed as a senior estimator with Harrison & Burrowes Bridge Constructors, Inc. in Glenmont. Previously, he worked at Tetra Tech and Delaney Construction.

Dick was a member of the Sacandaga Boating Club and enjoyed spending family time on the Great Sacandaga Lake. He was an avid snowmobiler as well as a NASCAR and football fan. Every spring and summer, he created an ever-expanding vegetable garden. Anyone who knew Dick knows he always had a project, and if you stopped by the house, chances are, you would too! He could fix or build just about anything. Dick loved traveling, going out to dinner, and entertaining family and friends at home. He was meticulously organized, and was never without his famous to-do lists.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by a brother, Robert; and two sisters, Linda McDonnell and Nellie Ann Kondrat.

Survivors include his wife, Amy Bombard Kondrat, who he married on March 17, 1974; two sons, Eric (Cindy) Kondrat of Hagaman and Ryan (Suzanne) Kondrat of Lockport; a brother, Paul (Margaret) Kondrat of Charlton; three

granddaughters, Veronica, Violet, and Grace, who were the light of his life; and several nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Cremation was performed at Park View Crematorium, Schenectady. Due to Covid restrictions, services will be held privately for the family. A celebration of life and final burial at St. Basil's Cemetery, Broadalbin, will take place at a later date.
