



## Richard Lince Sr.

July 20, 1948 - November 7, 2023

Richard Lince, Sr., 75, formerly of West 12th Avenue, Gloversville, passed away Tuesday, November 7, 2023, at Nathan Littauer Hospital.

He was born in Gloversville on July 20, 1948, a son of the late Paul and Doris Shutters Lince and was educated in local schools. Richard later attended FMCC. He was a lifelong area resident.

Mr. Lince was a veteran of the US Army and served two tours in Viet Nam, receiving two Purple Hearts and several commendations in that war. At age 55, he served a tour in Iraq as a member of the 424th Quartermaster Company. He was presented with the Bronze Star Medal for his heroic efforts while delivering vital supplies to other American troops.

He was employed at the WalMart Distribution Center in Johnstown and retired in 2011.

Richard was an avid bowler and loved following politics. Most of all, he loved spending time with family and friends.

Survivors include his wife, Cynthia Flint Lince, whom he married on July 10, 1971; three children, Richard Lince, Jr. and Amy (Kenneth) Razzano, all of Gloversville, and Eric (Vickie) Lince of Broadalbin; a sister, Carolyn (Joseph) Kadle of Gloversville; four grandchildren, Terra, Alex, and Benjamin Lince, and Jacobb Razzano; and several nieces, nephews, and cousins.
