



## Robert S. Kozlowski Jr.

June 11, 1959 - August 29, 2025

Robert S. Kozlowski, Jr., 66, of Stevers Mills Road, Broadalbin, passed away on Friday, August 29, 2025, at Nathan Littauer Hospital, Gloversville, with family at his side.

He was born in Schenectady on June 11, 1959, a son of Robert and Carol Lee DeSorbo Kozlowski and was a graduate of Galway High School. Robert lived in Broadalbin since 1985.

He was a pipefitter and welder and worked at Knolls Atomic Power in West Milton, retiring in 2021. Robert, along with two good friends, co-owned and -operated the former KRS Snowmobile in Broadalbin.

Robert was a man who enjoyed so many activities including cooking, snowmobiling, gardening, both flower and vegetable, and planting trees. Robert enjoyed rodeo and was a bull rider at local rodeos. He was proud to be able to do a one-handed push-up, up until 5 years ago. Robert had a love of birds, Formula 1, and enjoyed going to the Amish auctions.

In addition to his parents, Robert was predeceased by a stepbrother and his wife, Jesse and Linda Czubernat.

Survivors include his wife, Carolyn Winney Kozlowski, whom he married on September 27, 1986; two children, Kevan Kozlowski of Broadalbin and Kameryn Curtis (Ryan) of Galway; a brother, Jeffrey (Theresa) Kozlowski of Broadalbin; his stepmother, Jean Audy of Schenectady; a stepbrother, Peter Czubernat (Sue) of Schenectady; two grandchildren, Landon and Karsyn; and a nephew, Justin.
