Robert W. "Bob" Lindsay, Sr., 72, of County Highway 106, Johnstown, passed away on Saturday, August 27, 2022, at Nathan Littauer Hospital, Gloversville.

He was born in Amsterdam on April 21, 1950, a son of Wallace and Harriette Reamer Lindsay and was a 1968 graduate of Wilbur H. Lynch High School. Bob was a lifelong area resident.

Mr. Lindsay was employed as a machinist with his family's business, the former Inman's Manufacturing in Amsterdam. Later, he worked at Warren Electric in Gloversville.
