Robert P. Marshall, 68, of Perth, passed away on Friday March 19, 2021. He was born in Paris, France on April 20, 1952 a son of Frank and Eleanor Buchanan Marshall, who were serving as missionaries.

Bob worked for several leather mills in the area. He also started a leather factory in Africa. When he returned to the US, Bob was a school bus driver for Galway Central School and at the time of his death, he drove for Brown's Transportation in Amsterdam. He was also a newspaper carrier for the Gazette.

Bob was an avid outdoorsman and enjoyed hunting and fishing. He also loved teaching his grandchildren about archery, shooting, and fishing.

Mr. Marshall was very involved in church ministries throughout his life. He served as a deacon, a Sunday school teacher, and an AWANA leader. In recent years, Bob's desire was to send kids to camp to experience the joy of camping. This was accomplished with the assistance from his Gazette customers, who gave donations toward camp. In 2019, he was able to send twenty-five children to camp at the Sacandaga Bible Conference with money he raised for scholarships.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by a sister, Patricia Sebast. Survivors include his wife, Candice Korpi Marshall, whom he married on August 17, 1974; four daughters, Heather (Dave) Subik of Butte, MT, Heidi (Jason) McCausland of Lanesborough, MA, Hope (Daniel) Parsons of Reidsville, NC, and Holly (Joseph) Blongiewicz of Perth, NY; his siblings,
