Robert H. Patten, 83, of County Highway 155, Gloversville, died Monday May 23, 2016 at the Wells Nursing Home, Johnstown.

He was born in Utica on July 31, 1932 a son of James and Alice Failing Patten and lived in Palatine Bridge as a child. Bob was a 1950 graduate of Canajoharie High School and later attended Cobleskill Ag & Tech. He moved to Broadalbin in 1960.

Mr. Patten was employed as a shipping technician at Anderson Instrument in Glen, for thirty years. After retiring, he worked at the Broadalbin Transfer Station.

Mr. Patten was a fifty five year member of the Broadalbin United Methodist Church where he served as a trustee, sang in the choir, and was a MYF leader. He also was co-chair of the annual church fair for several years. Bob also volunteered at countless church suppers, and was best known for washing dishes.
