Roderick L. "Rod" MacIntosh, 80, of Mariners Road, Gloversville, NY, passed away on Tuesday, June 24, 2025, at Nathan Littauer Hospital.

He was born in Niskayuna on May 15, 1945, a son of William and Evelyn Borst MacIntosh and attended school in Scotia. Rod lived in Glenville and Ballston Spa before moving to the town of Mayfield, on the Great Sacandaga Lake.

Mr. MacIntosh owned and operated Seneca Auto, which was first located in Schenectady and later moved to Ballston Spa. Later, Rod was employed as a manager at Warren Tire in Colonie and later in Johnstown, for more than 20 years, retiring in 2013.

He enjoyed being outdoors and loved fishing, hunting, snowmobiling, and boating. Most of all, Rod loved living on the lake and spending time with family and friends.

Mr. MacIntosh was a veteran of the US Coast Guard and served from March 1964 to March 1968. Rod served in the reserves until 1970.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by a brother, John, and a sister, Cheryl.
