Rosanna "Rosa" Cotugno Priamo, 81, of Amsterdam, NY passed away peacefully on Thursday, May 6, 2021 at home surrounded by her family. She was born in Castel Compagnano, Province of Caserta, Italy on August 1, 1939 a daughter of the late Giuseppe and Erminia Torone Cotugno and was educated there. Rosa came to the United States at age eighteen.

On May 31, 1958, Rosa was united in marriage to the love of her life, Paul Priamo, Sr. They celebrated forty beautiful years together, raising eight children. Sadly, he died in June of 1998.

For over thirty years, Rosa was a devoted employee at St. Mary's Hospital until her retirement.

She was a woman of strong faith and was a longtime member of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church.

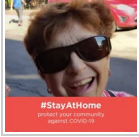
