Rose M. McGuire, 85, of Ridge Road, Amsterdam passed away on Saturday November 6, 2021, at Ellis Hospital with her loving family at her side.

She was born at home in the town of Broadalbin on February 7, 1936, a daughter of Ernest and Mattie Ross Stutzke and attended local schools. Rose was a lifelong area resident and enjoyed wintering in Florida for twenty-six years.
