Royal H. "Nick" Nickloy, II, 81, of Maple Avenue, Gloversville passed away on Saturday, June 13, 2026, at Ellis Hospital, Schenectady.

He was born in Gloversville on May 26, 1945, a son of Royal Hover and Margaret Roberts Nickloy. A lifelong area resident, Nick was a graduate of Gloversville High School.

Mr. Nickloy was a veteran of the US Army and served in the Pacific Theatre. Nick was a member of the Teamsters and Seafarers Union, where he served as Shop Steward.
