Russell E. VanNostrand, 81, of Kunz Road, Broadalbin died Wednesday December 10, 2014 at St. Mary's Healthcare, Amsterdam.

He was born in Mayfield on November 29, 1933 a son of Ross and Lucinda Sweet VanNostrand and attended local schools.

Russ served in the US Army from 1951 – 52 and later in the US Air Force from 1952-60 as part of the 75th Fighter Squadron. He was very proud of the fact that seven of his brothers proudly served our country in World War II and Korea.

Mr. VanNostrand was employed as a mechanic foreman with Clemente Concrete of Albany, retiring in 1995. He previously was employed at Barsons Construction in Albany.

Russ was a member and served as commander for several years of the VFW Post #8690, as well a member of the American Legion Post #337, both in Broadalbin. He also was a member and past commander of the Old Tryon County Council and a member of the Sampson AFB Veterans Association.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by six brothers, Jack, Donald, Kenneth, Gerald, Harry, and Everson; and two sisters, Betty and Martha.

brothers, Ted (Mary)VanNostrand of Florida and Jason (June) VanNostrand of Northville. He is also survived by grandchildren, great-grandchildren, nieces, nephews, and his best friends, his dogs, Bandit and Rascal.
