Sharon E. Brower, 81, of Lake Street, Mayfield passed away at home on Monday, February 2, 2026. She was loved and supported by her children and grandchildren for many months.

She was born in Amsterdam on August 8, 1944, a daughter of Richard and Betty Davison Lorey and lived in Mayfield her whole life. Sharon was a 1962 graduate of Mayfield High School and later attended Albany Medical Center School of Nursing. She touched the lives of many residents, their families, and her co-workers at Amsterdam Memorial Hospital and the Fulton County Infirmary, where she worked for more than 40 years combined as a Licensed Practical Nurse.

Sharon was a lifelong member of the Mayfield Central Presbyterian Church where she served as an Elder, participated in many committees, including the worship committee and youth group. She enjoyed selecting hymns for worship and ensuring appropriate offerings were provided for coffee hour.

She was an avid sports fan of the NY Yankees and the Amsterdam Mohawks. She would also root for the NFL teams that her children liked, depending on which one was present at the time. Sharon enjoyed reading and bird watching. Mostly, she enjoyed spending time with family.

She enjoyed all holidays, especially Christmas, always preparing everyone's favorite dishes, making sure everyone had their favorite dessert, and had beautiful holiday garb. She loved to decorate her home with detail, including placing icicles on her tree, individually and perfectly.

Sharon was a wonderful mother and grandmother. She fiercely raised three children on her own, never missing any part of their lives. She also was present and actively participated in the lives of her grandchildren.

On May 28, 1966, she married Gerald Brower who died November 22, 1983. Survivors include her daughters, Jill Kaczor (Jeff Ille) and Jane (Eric) Parker; her son, Todd (Tanya) Brower; her grandchildren who were the light of her life, Lauryn (J.J.) Sikorski and Sierra Brower; her great-grandson, Alexander Sikorski who she was thrilled to watch grow; and her brother, Thomas Lorey; her nephews, Christopher (Becky) Ryan, and Connyr Lorey. She is also survived by her “bonus” grandchildren, Ian and Jaret Warner, Natasha (Michael) Brayah, Zuri Allen, Brittany, Cameron, and Ariana Pollard.
