Shirley J. Alkinburgh, 76, of County Highway 106, Johnstown passed away at home on Wednesday, February 4, 2026, surrounded by her loving family. She was born in Gloversville on June 2, 1949, a daughter of Alex, Jr. and Florence Firth Aesch and was a 1967 graduate of Gloversville High School. Shirley was a lifelong area resident.

Family was everything to Shirley. Her most cherished times were spent with family and friends. She was selfless in her life's journey, making sure everyone in her circle was taken care of through love, guidance, empathy, and support. Shirley had several hobbies she enjoyed.
