Susan F. Crowther, 81, formerly of Thompson Street, Broadalbin passed away Tuesday February 16, 2021 in Wesley Chapel, FL.

She was born in Amsterdam, NY on May 25, 1939 a daughter of Warren and Elizabeth Burtch Furbeck and was a 1956 graduate of Gloversville High School. Sue lived in Gloversville and Fonda before moving to Broadalbin in 1962. She moved to Florida in October 2018 with her daughter, Sarah.

Mrs. Crowther was employed as a bookkeeper at Gates Mills in Gloversville for several years and also worked for other area businesses. After retiring, she was an office assistant for Dr. Edith Pryce in Gloversville.
