Susan M. Johnson, 76, of State Circle, Gloversville, passed away at home on Saturday, August 30, 2025.

She was born in Gloversville on April 13, 1949, the daughter of Carmen and Ida Rizzio Ruggiero and was a 1967 graduate of Bishop Burke High School. Susan was a lifelong area resident.

At the time of her death, Ms. Johnson was the second-generation co-owner of Pearl Leather Finishers in Johnstown, which was established in 1976 by her late father, Carmen Ruggiero.

Susan was a very generous and caring person who loved spending time with her family and friends. Her children and grandchildren were her whole life. She enjoyed watching all of her grandchildren's sporting events. She loved tending to her beautiful home, her flowers, and her six cats.
