



## Teresa A. Jaquay-Schrader

January 15, 1949 - January 20, 2021

Teresa A. Jaquay-Schrader, 72, of Gloversville passed away on Wednesday morning, January 20, 2021, at Nathan Littauer Hospital with her loving daughters and longtime companion at her side.

She was born in Gloversville on January 15, 1949, the daughter of Salvatore and Mary Viola Renda, and was a graduate of Gloversville High School. Teresa was a lifelong area resident.

Having suffered polio at a young age, Teresa went on to live her life as a strong, independent woman. Teresa was employed at GTE, which later became Contel, Grandoe, JBF, and later worked at FMS Work Force Solutions in Gloversville.

She loved cooking and flower gardening, but most of all she enjoyed spending time with her family and friends.

She was married to Steven Jaquay from August 31, 1966 until he passed away on March 4, 1997. In addition to her husband, she was predeceased by her father and her brother Thomas.
