Theodore J. Loucks, 69, of Broadalbin, passed away Thursday, October 31, 2024, at Nathan Littauer Hospital, Gloversville.

He was born in Great Barrington, MA on June 9, 1955, a son of the late Theodore Miles and Betty Loucks. He attended parochial school at St. Lawrence O'Toole and then Brewster High School. He moved to Indio, CA in 1977 and was employed at Houston Lumber Co. until retiring due to disability. Ted returned to upstate New York in 1980 and lived in Broadalbin. He loved living near the Sacandaga Lake and often spoke of the area as "God's country".

Ted was an absolute "gear head" and loved drag racing at Lebanon Valley Speedway and racing snowmobiles on Sacandaga Lake. He also loved fishing, tending to his beautiful garden and Converse sneakers. Ted was also known as being a walking encyclopedia – he just knew everything. From cars to home repair issues...Ted always had a solution. He was just a phenomenal guy. Ted was like dad to Robin's sister Tracey and her nieces, Melanie and Ashley.

Survivors include his longtime companion and soul mate Robin; his devoted chocolate lab, Gauge; his beloved stray cat, Mickey; and Robin's family, including her mother Beverly Morris, and her four sisters: Sherry, Sioux, Sandie, and Tracey.
