



Thomas A. Canty II

Thomas A. "T.A." Canty, II, 45, of Kingsboro Ave., Gloversville, passed away at home on Monday, November 21, 2022, with loved ones at his side.

He was born in Hudson on October 31, 1977, a son of Thomas A. and Barbara A. Taylor Canty and moved to Johnstown in 1988. T.A. was a 1996 graduate of Gloversville High School and later attended Sacred Heart University in Fairfield, CT. After college, he moved to Gloversville.

Mr. Canty owned and operated the former Glove City Sports Lounge for three years. He later worked at Frontier Communication for nearly fifteen years. Most recently, T.A. worked as an account executive for Spectrum in Albany, until the onset of illness.

T.A. was a certified referee with the IABBO, the International Assoc. of Approved Basketball Officials, and reached the varsity level for high school athletics. He enjoyed coaching youth sports locally. T.A. was an avid NY Yankee and NY Giants fan. He loved spending time with family and friends, especially his children.

Mr. Canty served as a board member for the Gloversville School District.

He was predeceased by his father.

Survivors include two children, Sophia Rauscher-Canty and Nasir Canty; his mother, Barbara A. Canty of Amsterdam; two brothers, Robert (Elizabeth "Beth") Taylor of Amsterdam and William Canty of Bushkill, PA; three sisters, Jessica Canty of Gloversville, Kayah Canty-Payton of Hudson, and Indya Roscoe of Glens Falls; his nieces and nephews, Javon, Andre, Preston, and Elijah Taylor, Sydney, Symone, and Caleb Canty; an aunt, Lynda Robinson; an uncle, Gus Robinson; his longtime companion, Amanda DiMaio, and her son, Zachary Thompson.
