



## Thomas E. Smith Jr.

Thomas E. Smith, Jr., 85, of South Second Avenue, Broadalbin, passed away Thursday, May 26, 2022, at home.

He was born in Jersey City, NJ on February 19, 1937, a son of Thomas and Pauline Topp Smith, and was educated there. Tom enlisted in the US Navy and served for four years. Following his discharge, he soon realized the job market at the time was unstable and so he decided to return to military life. He would spend the next twenty years in the US Navy, with his bride and growing family serving in Norfolk, VA, Rhode Island, and Yokohama, Japan.

Mr. Smith retired in 1977 and moved to Broadalbin. Tom returned to the work force and spent the next twenty years working at the Albany Post Office and retired again in 1998.

He loved working on his computer and enjoyed maintaining his home. Tom took pride in his property and always enjoyed doing yardwork.

He married Charleen Brooks on November 25, 1962. Sadly, she died on October 14, 2018. In addition to his wife and parents, he was predeceased by a brother, Willy Smith; and two sisters, Loraine Lowe and Helen Holleran.
