Timothy M. Hime, 70, of North Main Street, Gloversville, passed away at home on Saturday, October 28, 2023.

He was born in Gloversville on December 1, 1952, a son of Douglas and Jean Snell Hime and was a 1970 graduate of Mayfield High School. Later, he served in the US Marine Corps and was honorably discharged in 1975. Tim graduated from the University of Houston with a BS degree in psychology, and later earned a master's degree in public administration from American University in Washington, DC.

Mr. Hime worked in the field of special needs for the majority of his career. He was last employed as the director of program operations at the Special Needs Program, Inc. in Hudson, where he worked for twenty years. Tim had the unique ability to relate to people with special needs and provide the tools and opportunities for them to achieve their full potential.

He was an active member of the Mayfield United Methodist Church. He sang in the choir in his youth and continued serving the church by leading several church committees. Tim enjoyed decorating the church for all seasons.

He was a strong supporter of family and friends through life's ups and downs. Tim enjoyed the outdoors and was an avid hiker and camper.

Survivors include a brother, Shaun (LauraBelle) Hime of Mayfield; a sister, Scherrie Plumadore of Hagerstown, MD; an aunt, Donna Hime; and several nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Cremation was performed at Park View Crematorium, Schenectady. A military graveside service will be held at Ferndale Cemetery, Johnstown and will be announced in the spring. Arrangements are by the Robert M. Halgas Funeral Home, Inc., Johnstown, NY.
