Timothy M. Hyde, 69, of Midline Road, Amsterdam, passed away on Saturday, January 6, 2024, at Ellis Hospital.

He was born in Albany on November 24, 1954, a son of Robert and Claire Mead Hyde and was a 1972 graduate of Gloversville High School. Tim later attended HVCC. He was a lifelong area resident. Tim refurbished a home in Hagaman where he lived for twenty-five years, before moving to Amsterdam. He was employed as an electrical worker and was a member of the IBEW Local #236 of Albany.

Tim was an avid drummer and loved music and singing. He enjoyed puttering around the house, cooking outside, and using the pool every summer. Mostly, he loved spending time with his family and friends, and riding in the red mustang. Tim enjoyed visits from his great-granddaughter, Kota, who was the apple of his eye.

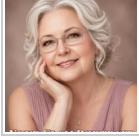
