



Todd A. "Turbo" Gasner

Our hearts are broken as we acknowledge the passing of our Todd "Turbo" Gasner on Thursday, March 9, 2023, at his home in Johnstown.

He was born at St. Mary's Hospital on September 7, 1965, a son of Harold and Joanne Zabawczuk Gasner. Todd was a 1984 graduate of the former Broadalbin High School where he played on the basketball and football teams. He was employed for more than thirty years at UPS as a tractor trailer driver, retiring in 2020.

His greatest passion was Moto Cross racing where he was very successful for many years. He also enjoyed snowmobiling, kayaking, and spending time with his precious nieces and nephews.

Todd was always there for anyone who needed him and volunteered at local food pantries.

Todd was of the Catholic faith.

He was predeceased by his father in 2016.

Survivors include his mother, Joanne Gasner of Broadalbin; his brother, Scott M. Gasner of Broadalbin; his niece, Macey (Erik) Rorick; his nephew, Nathan Gasner; and precious great-niece and great-nephew, Hazel and Barrett Rorick, who were especially dear to his heart. He is also survived by several aunts and cousins, including a second cousin, Troy Zabaczuk, Jr., who Todd was caring for after Troy's father died in 2012. He was also very close to Rick Von Robel, II of Redmond, WA, who he knew since Rick was an infant.

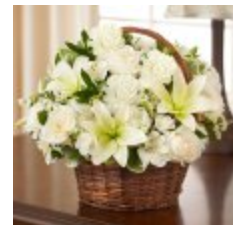
