Tracy L. Rowback, 60, formerly of Mayfield, passed away on Wednesday, April 8, 2026, at Saratoga Hospital following a long illness. She was surrounded by her loving family.

Tracy was born in Gloversville on April 29, 1965, a daughter of Franklin and Ruth Seelow Warner and was a 1983 graduate of Mayfield Central School. She was a lifelong area resident.

Tracy was employed at Stewart's in Mayfield for several years. She later worked as a teller at NBT in Gloversville and retired due to disability in 2024. Tracy was a member of the Mayfield Grill Pitch League and enjoyed playing Yahtzee with her best friend, Linda. She also loved traveling, enjoying cruises and the ocean. Tracy was a popular and esteemed member of the Pokemon Go community. Most of all, she loved spending time with her family and friends. Tracy made a lasting impact on so many people, from her former co-workers and customers to those who cared for her while she was hospitalized. She will be remembered for her kindness and caring heart. The family would like to thank the amazing staff at Saratoga Hospital for caring for and treating her like family during her stay there.

In addition to her parents, Tracy was predeceased by her stepfather, Edward Sowle, two sisters, Elizabeth Warner and Joan Sowle, and her brother-in-law, John "Jack" Albertin.

Survivors include two children, Brandon (Kelsey) Rowback of Corinth and Ashley Rowback of Palmetto, FL; a brother, Franklin Warner, Jr. of Mayfield;

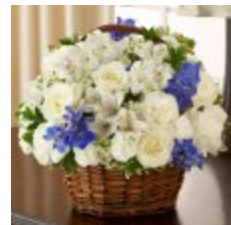
