William “Roy” Pearsall, age 93, of Edinburg passed away peacefully Sunday, March 5, 2017 at St. Mary’s Hospital in Amsterdam after a brief illness.

He was born in Northville on April 7, 1923 the son of William and Anna Pearsall. Roy was a loving husband, father, grandfather and friend. In 1948, he married Betty DeMagistris and together they had three children.

As a young man in Northville, Roy was the definition of industriousness: he did everything from selling soda to vacationers to apprenticing himself to an electrician to learn that trade. During WW II, Roy served in the US Navy aboard the USS Dynamic. After the War, he was the Service Manager at Parson’s Ford in Gloversville and then for many years he worked as the Equipment Supervisor at Crushed Rock Products in Schenectady.

In recent years, Roy loved country dancing on Sundays with his beloved Vicky and was a member of the Country Round and Square Dance Association. He was also a member of the Adirondack Fiddlers Club, the Gloversville Moose and the Gloversville Concordia Club.

Roy will be greatly missed by his loving partner, Vicky Michalek; his three children, Linda (James) Pascale of Fort Lauderdale, FL, Timothy Pearsall of Saratoga Springs, NY, and Elaine (Randall) Mentry; a sister, Grace Nelson of

Ocala, FL; three grandchildren, James (Naomi), Daniel (Vanessa), and Andrew; as well as many nieces, nephews and dear friends.
